

Same Bottle. Less Plastic.

Coca-Cola Canada Bottling is

**on a journey Toward a
Better Future Together.**

We're working to collect a bottle or can for every one we produce by 2030, ensuring our packaging is recyclable and using more recycled content. As we do, we're also looking for ways to minimize the amount of plastic packaging we use. Even removing small amounts of plastic from one of our already low-weight PET beverage bottles can make a difference.

Here is an update on our progress.

We've reduced the plastic content in

90%

of the products we make, distribute, merchandise and sell.

We're now using

**11% less
virgin plastic**

across our product packaging (with continued reductions planned). And our bottles weigh less too.



By reducing the plastic in our bottles and using recycled plastic, we've avoided

1,786,000kg

of plastic in our packaging.

That's almost

1.8 million!

**Over 3,900
tonnes**

of CO₂ have been removed, through plastic reduction and the increased use of recycled plastic. The equivalent carbon footprint of

850 cars.

We recognize we still have work to do.
